- The Legionaries continue to have a good ecclesial relationship with Hamilton Diocese.
- Two CWRC visited last May to assist with Challenge camp
- Started piloting the Leadership Challenge study course as content for our monthly Spirituality of the Movement session
- We had a member from our locality attend the Territorial Assembly in Chicago
- The Apostolate team are working to connect with more members, by reaching out to those members that have not been attending activities recently, to accompany them where they are.
- Women’s retreat in October reached full capacity (first time ever in our locality)
- Women’s team personally accompanying the NON RC women who attended the retreat weekend in October 2017
- Young Adult members have started meeting regularly, forming friendships (10 -15 of them participating) and 4 of them completed the RC discernment course
- Two men’s teams have started the Discernment course (Nov 2017)
- Increased communication with Conquest /Challenge club leaders regarding connection to ECyD/ RC. Invited ECyD members to renew pledge at CTK and sending RC Ontario newsletter to club presidents who are not RC (Milton)

- Two of the 6 EwC team surveyed have a shared team apostolate, the others have individual apostolates assisting with Challenge or Conquest clubs.
- Have organized social events for RC members, including Spring Pot Luck when CWRC visited; Picnic for the moms in July; Rhetoric night in August; RC family picnic in September;
- 5 young men attended the TYC retreat in Cheshire in May.
- In September, two new Conquest clubs and two new Challenge clubs will be starting, which will bring us to 6 Conquest and 6 Challenge clubs. We also have a member leading up a Challenge Jr. club.
- Registrations for CTK celebration reached full capacity prior to the event and was all organizing by RC Young Adults
- 3 new young adult members joined the movement at CTK
- Fall Youth Activities: CQ Team Leader Formation Weekend (St Peter's Weekend); CQ Saints vs. Zombies Weekend; CH Super Faith Weekend; Father/Son Day Retreat
- Summer Camps since May - A new CQ/CH Summer Day Camp was started by CQ/CH adult leaders in Ajax this past summer; Annual CQ/CH Summer Day Camp in Oakville; Annual CQ/CH Summer Day Camp in Hamilton; ECYD Leadership Experience for High School Boys and Camp Christ the King
